Reading/Writing/Spelling

This week in reading we have enjoyed reading two stories. We echo and choral read as a class. We talked about the patterns we see and about how to use the pictures for help. We also practiced the sound of "b" and counting syllables in words. Be sure to practice their 23 kindergarten words.



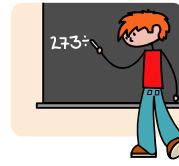
In writing, we continued to concentrate on our handwriting. We have learned how to correctly form letters such as g, c, and e. Please continue to practice with your child at home. The more practice the better! We wrote and illustrated a sentence about what we liked to play. We also reviewed how sentences begin and end.



Math

This week in math we continued to play Compare and Double Compare. We also built staircases with cubes. We practiced putting numbers in order from 1-12 and then we used cubes to build the staircases to represent this. We introduced using pictures, words,

and numbers to solve math problems and practiced a few.

This week for Fun Friday we discussed the topic of "Families" for our Social Studies unit. We talked about the different types of families and the importance of each. We also made family trees using our portraits that were sent in. These will go in your child's "My Life" folders that will come home at the end of the year!
