Reading/Writing/Spelling

This week in reading we read the story "Sometimes" from our text. We worked on contractions (I am = I'm), beginning sounds and rhyming.

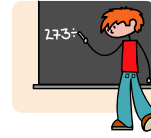
We are journaling everyday which gives us practice with complete sentences, capitals and periods. We are continuing to learn new hunks and chunks in the Phonics Dance. This week we learned "all" and "ing". The students are already using these chunks in their journaling!



Math

This week in math we worked on "Quick Images". These are dot pictures that are shown for 5 seconds on the overhead projector and your child must try to copy the image on paper. We discuss ways to remember the images such as making a picture with the dots, grouping the dots and/or

counting the dots. These are great problem solving strategies and will be used throughout the year. We also worked more with pattern blocks this week. FUN!



Fun Friday

This week we discussed solids and liquids. We worked on two centers throughout the week where we explored solids. We then finished the week with exploring liquids. The students really enjoyed these stations. Be sure to ask your child about his/her favorite!
