Reading/Writing/Spelling

This week in reading we read the story "Five Little Rabbits" from our text. We worked on adding -ed and -ing to words such as play and jump and we also discussed the difference between fiction and non-fiction.

This week we wrote our own version of "Five Little Rabbits" by filling in a story frame. The students did an amazing job on this project! A favorite of mine was, "Two little dolphins splashing on a wave. One fell off and he just swam." Be sure to keep your eye out for your child's writing!



Math

This week in math we worked on finding ways to make 12 and 10. The students were given a problem such as, "I have 12 pets. Some are cats and some are dogs. How many of each

could I have?" They could use pictures, numbers or words to find solutions and we came together to share what they found. This can be a difficult concept, but they are catching on quickly!

Fun Friday

This week we continued our discussion of solids and liquids. The students were paired up to take an object to several stations to explore characteristics of the object. They took a journal to each station to record their results and were able to decide if their object was a solid or a liquid.
